The information workshop will be an occasion to introduce to media and information specialists the Programme and eventually to plan/produce multimedia stories on related activities to inform effectively their audiences about sustainable water management policies and practices in the Southern Mediterranean Region.

Participants will have the opportunity to actively contribute to a debate about central issues presented by SWIM experts and possibly during a field visit to one of the Demonstration projects (to be organized at a later stage).

Finally, the objective of the Information Workshops is also to set-up a sort of "Media Circle" specialized in environment/water management related issues in the SWIM Partner Countries.
